More holiday flights and new routes: Sundair expands services from Dresden

Sundair is strengthening its commitment to Dresden Airport. In summer 2020 the airline will be stationing a second aircraft there and will be flying to Palma de Mallorca and Varna. Two new holiday destinations that feature in the summer timetable for the first time are Fuerteventura and Hurgada. Holidaymakers can also fly to Antalya, Heraklion, Kos and Rhodes. This brings the number of weekly Sundair departures and arrivals at Dresden Airport from 28 to 40. The additional flights will be operated with an Airbus A320. The new flights are already open for booking.

Götz Ahmelmann, CEO of Mitteldeutscher Flughafen AG adds: “Demand for tourist flights in the Dresden Airport catchment area is strong. We are delighted that Sundair is tapping into this potential and expanding its offerings just a few months after first establishing a base here. This will widen the choice of destinations available to holidaymakers and give them more flexibility in planning their holidays.”

Sundair opened a base at Dresden Airport and stationed an Airbus A320 there at the beginning of May 2019. The airline currently flies passengers to Heraklion, Rhodes, Kos and Antalya every week.

In the winter timetable, which begins at the end of October, Sundair will be flying to Fuerteventura, Gran Canaria and Tenerife. Sun-seekers also have a choice of two more non-stop destinations from Dresden with Sundair: Hurgada and Marsa Alam.

Sundair is a young, independent airline founded in 2016 with headquarters in Stralsund and bases at Kassel, Berlin Tegel, Dresden and Bremen airports. Sundair flies holidaymakers to the most beautiful destinations in the Mediterranean, the Red Sea and the Canary Islands. It also operates special and charter flights and is an ACMI provider for other airlines. Its modern fleet currently consists of five aircraft from the European manufacturer Airbus: four A320-214s and one A319-111. Another Airbus A319-111 will boost the Sundair fleet in late summer 2019.

Thanks to the direct access road from the A4 motorway, 3000 parking spaces right next to the terminal building and the S-Bahn station, passengers from Saxony, Southern Brandenburg, Northern Bohemia and Lower Silesia can get to the airport easily and comfortably.

Short and barrier-free routes are characteristic of the unique Dresden Airport Terminal, a former aviation industry hangar. Arrivals and Departures as well as service areas can all be found under one roof. It is also home to Dresden's biggest travel centre, the Gate 14 airport shop (www.gate14.de) and a conference and events centre with a panoramic view of aircraft on the apron. The customer service was awarded the "Service Quality in Germany" level II certificate by the Saxon Tourist Board.
